



Our final goal for a DXpedition or ham-activity is to reach a rare one and of course to get it confirmed. Also in times of LOTW and eQSL many hams prefer the paper-QSL.

In earlier times one of the important sentences was „the final courtesy of a QSO is a QSL-card“

The quality of QSL-cards has extreme improved against 20 years ago. However in many cases it´s more and more difficult to get a card at all.

In the late 80s we started a publication called QSL-policy. Mainly we recorded which DXstations/QSL-manager confirm via buro, direct or nothing on both ways.

Ham-Radio is like a virus, when there is an operator enjoy the pile-up he will do this mostly several times in the future also. So when you had bad results this expedition you will know it for the next one and can decide if its worth to stand in the pile-up or the waste an envelope with donation. We included the QSLpolicy file together in our QSL-manager-database WINQSL.

Meanwhile we received numerous requests if there is an interest to publish the QSLpolicy listing alone as there are a big number of sources for manager-listings available.

So here we are with WIN-QSL-POLICY (1st Release). There are currently some more wishes which will be included in the next one.

To spread out the words in a wide community we decided to make it a very cheap product.

There are two different licences available.

**1. The club licence:**

all ham-radio-clubs, organisations can get the product for **free**, you only need to fill out the form and send it via fax or e-mail and you will get a licence-file for your club.

**2. The individual-licence:**

the fee is 6US\$ including the next three updates (updates are planned approximately each three month).

When you load the program from the homepage you can test it before, as it allows 100 starts before it needs to be registered.

There are currently QSL-policy informations for about 10000 QSL-manager and DX-stations included.
